



## Transcript for Strip

### 001 — A Place To Be Yourself

Panel 1: On a busy city street, we see attorney Ophelia Featherstone scowling as she leaves her office building to go home. *What a day!* she thinks. *I never thought it would end.*

Panel 2: On the front stoop of a suburban house, she puts a key into the lock of the front door. Smiling now, she thinks, *That's why it's always a relief to come home after a long day.*

Panel 3: The double-wide panel shows the living room of a particularly different type of house, where the five human residents become their anthropomorphic (“furry”) selves. On the sofa, a white tiger and a red kangaroo are playing a video game; a badger sits in a chair, reading a book; and a red fox sits at a table, working on some macrame.
