



## Transcript for Strip

### 005 — Native Learning

- Panel 1: Gordon James Stevens (“Lightfoot”), a slim red fox anthro, sits in a straight-backed chair; on a small table in front of him, a macrame project has his attention. He is dressed in blue jeans and a lightweight leather vest of sandy brown. The narration bar reads: *This is Lightfoot, a Cheyenne red fox.* Lightfoot says, “Haáhe.” (Cheyenne greeting, like “hello.”)
- Panel 2: As Lightfoot continues to work, the narration bar reads: *A Native American fox from the southwestern deserts, Lightfoot is...* The fox gently interrupts with, “Nope.”
