

Transcript for Strip 035 — Library Still Life

- Panel 1: Lightfoot, in his human form, is letting himself into the library where he works. Instead of his usual vest, he's wearing a blue-gray button-down shirt. A narration bar at the top of the panel reads, *In the gray dawn of morning, the cleverly disguised fox lets himself into another of his sanctuaries: The public library.*

- Panel 4: Lightfoot stands next to a framed picture of Kurt Vonnegut. The narration bar reads, *We apologize for the behavior of the crazy fox.*Lightfoot shrugs and says, "Suit yourself." The poster of Kurt Vonnegut says, "So it goes."
